**Resolution number 2019-02-#04**

***Policy on Major School Change – Consultation Launch***

WHEREAS, by virtue of Resolution 2007-09-#04, the Council of Commissioners adopted the Policy on Major School Change of the Lester B. Pearson School Board (LBPSB); and

WHEREAS Council and Administration indicated that certain modifications were required in order to update the text of the Policy, in compliance with subsequent changes to the *Education Act*; and

WHEREAS the School Board wishes to consult the community and the consultative partners of LBPSB on the draft of the *Policy on Major School Change – A Policy on the Distribution of Educational Services*:


WHEREFORE IT WAS MOVED BY Commissioner J. Doan AND UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED:

THAT the draft of the *Policy on Major School Change – A Policy on the Distribution of Educational Services* of the Lester B. Pearson School Board be distributed for consultation to the Staff Members, Central Students' Committee, Parents' Committee, the Governing Boards and other consultative partners during the week of February 25, 2019, with responses to be returned to the Secretariat no later than Monday, April 23, 2019, for consideration of the responses; and

THAT the final draft of the Lester B. Pearson School Board Major School Change Policy be adopted at the regular meeting of the Council of Commissioners of April 29, 2019.
