Please note that the capacity of each school is calculated through the Minister of Education class ratios. The projected school enrollment for the years 2019-2022 is determined through enrollment and data from Statistics Canada and la *Direction de la recherche, des statistiques et de l'information from the Minister of Education Leisure and Sports*. This projected enrollment is reviewed and is revised if there are recent changes to demographics in a school's enrollment area.
