QUESTION PERIOD

The second question period will be at the end of the agenda and reserved for questions that have arisen from items on that agenda.

- At Executive Committee meetings, there will be one question period following the adoption of the agenda and approval of the minutes.

STEPS TO ASK A QUESTION

To ask a live question at question period, please follow the steps below:

STEP 1: Log into the webinar with your first and last name (not an alias).

STEP 2: Indicate in the Q&A section that you wish to ask a question and please include your first and last name in that section. A list of speakers will be established based on their order of appearance in the Q&A section.

STEP 3: Once your name is called, you will be invited to speak.

RULES

- Speakers will be given a maximum of 3 minutes.
- Each question period shall last at most 15 minutes unless otherwise extended by the Chair.
- The Chair may declare inadmissible and will immediately terminate any question or comment that:
 - a. is not related to matters that fall under the Council of Commissioners'/the Executive Committee's mandate; or
 - b. is regarding a matter pending before the courts or quasi-judicial bodies, or which is under investigation or part of on-going negotiations; or
 - c. is deemed to be of a personal or confidential nature, or
 - d. is deemed to be abusive, offensive or that constitutes a personal attack.
