



School board election on December 20, 2020 Public notice of the revision of the list of electors and of Vote by Mail

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to the electors of the school board that:

1. The list of electors of the entire territory of LBPSB is subject to revision and may be consulted at the office of the returning officer. To verify if you are registered, please consult: <https://boardsite.lbpsb.qc.ca/school-board-election#List>.
2. To be registered on the list of electors, any person must, on polling day (December 20, 2020):
 - **Be:** at least 18 years of age; Canadian citizen; domiciled in the territory of the school board and having been domiciled in Quebec for at least six (6) months;
Not: be under curatorship and not have been convicted, within the last five years, of an offence constituting a corrupt electoral or referendum practice; **and:**
 - Have a child admitted to the educational services of the LBPSB **or** have registered on the list of electors of LBPSB by completing the notice of choice or registration form available at: <https://boardsite.lbpsb.qc.ca/school-board-election#General> and return it to: consultations@lbpsb.qc.ca by December 1, 2020, or by appearing on the days and times specified below:

3. When applying for registration before the Board of revisors, the previous address of the person concerned must be indicated. In addition, two documents must be submitted: one showing name and date of birth and the other showing name and domiciliary address.

EXCEPTIONAL MEASURES RELATED TO COVID-19: REVISION OF LIST OF ELECTORS AND VOTE BY MAIL

4. Under Ministerial Order 2020-091, Mobile Polling Stations will not be held. Individuals domiciled in a CHSLD or a private residence for seniors identified in the register established under the *Act respecting health services and social services* may request in writing a change to the list of electors by sending their request to the returning officer, no later than December 1, 2020. These forms are available on the website at: <https://boardsite.lbpsb.qc.ca/school-board-election#General>. 5. Under Order 2020-091, are considered in isolation the individuals:
Who are returning from a trip abroad in the last 14 days; who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are still considered carriers of the disease; who have symptoms of COVID-19; who have been in contact with a suspected, probable or confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days or who are waiting for a COVID-19 test result.
6. An application for registration by either category of individuals listed above must be submitted to the Returning Officer and accompanied by the following documents, as applicable:
An attestation from a member of the CHSLD staff or from the residence confirming the identity and place of residence of the individual; **or** a copy of two documents, one of which states the name and date of birth and the other the name and domiciliary address of the individual.
7. Categories of individuals listed above may also make a verbal or written request to vote by mail by contacting the Returning Officer before December 10, 2020, in writing or by phone, or by registering at: <https://boardsite.lbpsb.qc.ca/school-board-election#List>. Instructions: enter your postal code, civic number, verify if you are registered by entering your date of birth, click the Register button and the Confirm button.
8. Vote by mail instructions and envelopes for the eligible individuals who requested it will be mailed as of December 4, 2020. **Completed ballots must be returned before 4:30 pm on December 18, 2020.**
